### Side Event: Innovations and Effective Climate Finance for Low Carbon Transport

- How to structure climate funds (such as the Green Climate Fund) to make them work for sustainable transport?

Furthermore, Experience from Taiwan will be shared that include funding mechanisms for a public bicycle system in Taipei City as well as the potential of GHG Reduction through Electronic Toll Collection.

The TRANSfer project is a project run by GIZ and funded by the International Climate Initiative of the German Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Building and Nuclear Safety (BMUB). Its objective is to support developing countries to develop and implement climate change mitigation strategies in the transport sector as „Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions“ (NAMAs). Activities at country and international level are closely linked and designed in a mutually beneficial way. While specific country experience is broad to the international stage (bottom-up) to facilitate appropriate consideration of transport sector specifics in the climate change regime, recent developments in the climate change discussions are fed into the work in the partner countries (top-down).
